## FOREWORD TO THE REPORT

We wish to make it clear that this Report is not the Annual Report of the Manly-Warringah Sea Eagles Limited (the Sea Eagles) which is a separate legal entity from the Manly-Warringah Rugby League Football Club Limited (the Football Club).

It's been suggested by a representative of the management and the private owner of the Sea Eagles that by producing this report in the past and in some of our other communications to members that we are in some way seeking to misrepresent ourselves as the Sea Eagles. We have been also threatened with legal action to this effect. That was never our intent.

Since the privatisation of the Club, the Football Club has produced an annual report which documents the season past and stands as an historical record. We believe the Report is a valuable contribution to the Club as a whole. The production of the Report is done on a voluntary, unpaid basis, and the cost of printing the Report is funded by the Football Club and its members.

This year, for the first time since the privatisation of the Club, the Sea Eagles have denied us access to reports, statistics or photographs for the Report. This is a disappointing turn of events and has made the task of producing the normal report that we know many members treasure, very difficult. Given these factors, the Board initially decided not to produce a report, however having given it further consideration, we felt honour bound to continue the long standing history of producing the records of the Club. We believe that any player who has worn the Sea Eagles jersey in the First Grade/NRL, NSW Cup or Holden Cup, deserves to have their name recorded for posterity in the same form it has been produced since 1947.

Since the privatisation of the Club, the Football Club has assiduously maintained the system of allocating a number to every player who has played a match in the First Grade/NRL team. We also funded professional assistance to ensure it was done correctly. Whether it be one game or 300 games, every first grade player is given a unique, permanent number from the day they make their debut.

Following a request from the management, we have recently given the Sea Eagles access to this data so each current NRL player can have their own number sewn on to their backpacks – an initiative we applaud and hope to see extended eventually to their club shirts or player jerseys.

This Report has been compiled in a short period of time from publicly available data and our own records. It is not as complete as we would like it to be. The exception to this is the coach Trent Barrett who, when approached directly by our Chairman, was happy to provide a report. Due to the time constraints, the coaches of the NSW Cup and Holden Cup sides were not asked for a report, so the absence of their reports is not due to a refusal to cooperate.

We will review our approach to future Annual Reports over the coming year.


