Jack was elected a Life Member of the Football Club in 1985. He was also a Life Member of Manly Leagues Club, Manly-Warringah Junior League, Referees Association and NSW Leagues Club Association. Jack passed away in June, aged 87.



James Collins was a foundation member of the Leagues Club, Secretary of the Junior League for many years and was also Third Grade manager. James was elected a Life Member of the Football Club in 1974 and was also a Life Member of the Manly-Warringah Junior League. James passed away in August, aged 83.

Our condolences go to both the Martin and Collins families. Both men will be sadly missed, but their magnificent contributions to our Club will never be forgotten.

Our deepest sympathies are extended to the families of all Football Club members and past players of the Manly-Warringah Sea Eagles whom have passed away during the 2007 season.

COACHING REPORT

The steady rise and rebuilding of the Manly Sea Eagles over the past five seasons culminated in the club's first grand final appearance in a decade in 2007. Although beaten in the grand final by minor premiers Melbourne, the 2007 season was one of great significance for the club.

On and off the field Manly have made great strides and it is satisfying for all concerned that the club has re-emerged as a power in the NRL again. The playing group was a close knit and determined team who worked very hard for their success. Manly won 18 of the 24 matches played in the premiership and two out of the three finals matches. That success rate in such a high powered and keenly contested competition was an outstanding effort.

Many of the goals set for the season were achieved and to go from fifth place in 2006 to second in 2007 was satisfying. The Melbourne Storm are worthy premiers and were outstanding in the grand final. It should be noted that they were beaten in the grand final the season before and they did not let their second chance pass them by. We have to learn a similar lesson and I am sure we will.

There were many highlights during the 2007 season.

- The continued big crowds at Brookvale Oval in support of the maroon and whites was inspiringparticularly the large number of female and young fans. Average home ground crowds were 15,090.
- The re-establishing of Brookvale Oval as a Fortress again, with 10 wins and 1 loss.
- Steve Menzies broke the record for most number of first grade games for the club, surpassing the former record holder, Cliff Lyons (309 games).
- Steve Menzies also became the 2nd highest try scorer in Rugby League of all time with 167 tries, behind only fellow Manly legend, Ken Irvine (212 tries).
- Brett Stewart won his NSW State of Origin and Australian Test jerseys.
- Brent Kite continued his representative selection in the NSW and Australian teams.
- Manly won the Steve Rogers Memorial Trophy match against the Sharks at Toyota Park. The win broke a massive losing streak at the Shire ground.
- Manly won the inaugural Malcolm Reilly Trophy with a smashing 50-16 win over Newcastle in Gosford in round 22.
- Manly scored 105 tries in the premiership - second to Melbourne with 113.
- Manly conceded 62 tries in the premiership - second again to Melbourne (47).
- Mark Bryant and Michael Robertson played in all 27 games during 2007.
- Local juniors Anthony Watmough and Jason King played their 100th first grade games during the season.
- Luke Williamson played his 200th first grade game in the grand final.

I am delighted that Manly were able to blood young players during 2007 with Michael Bani, Vic Mauro, Shane Neumann, Sione Finefeauaki and Jason Wells making their first grade debuts. Manly used 29 players in the 2007 campaign which is a credit to the coaching, medical and rehabilitation staff.

The 2008 season - the game's centenary year - will be an important one for the club. The bar has been set at a very high level and there is now great expectation from sponsors and fans to continue the recent run of success. There has been a tremendous attitude to summer training and we will again be one of the fittest teams in the 2008 campaign.

I wish the departing players all the best in the new careers and welcome the newcomers to the Sea Eagles.

I would also like to thank the Manly-Warringah Sea Eagles Limited Board and the Manly-Warringah Rugby League Football Club Limited Board for their total support. Also the major shareholders - the Delmege and Penn families - have been wonderful to work with and hopefully we can bring a premiership back to the peninsula next season.

JUNIOR LEAGUE REPORT

On behalf of all members of the Junior Rugby League, I record our appreciation not only to our major sponsor, Manly Leagues Club, but special recognition of our 600 volunteers who work tirelessly throughout the season at Club level.

In 2007 we celebrated our 75th year of great sportsmanship and promotion of Junior Rugby League in the Manly-Warringah district. Throughout the year, in excess of 2,200 players participated in competitions in age brackets from under 6yrs educational programs to open age A Grade.

During 2007, the Junior Rugby League established another milestone as Adam Cuthbertson, a junior graduate from the Avalon Bulldogs, established himself in First Grade as one of the Sea Eagles most talented and devastating players. In addition, we produced another potential champion in Vic Mauro, from the North Curl Curl club, who made his First Grade debut for the Sea Eagles late in the season.

Your Junior Rugby League has perhaps the proudest history of all Junior Rugby Leagues in the metropolitan area in terms of producing home grown talent. In 2007, the Manly Sea Eagles First Grade squad not only included the two mentioned above, but other local juniors, Steve Menzies, Anthony Watmough and Jason King. What an achievement.

I must say that I was saddened when I read a report that one of the private shareholders had indicated in a press statement that the Sea Eagles would be supporting junior development on the Sunshine Coast. In my opinion, money is better spent locally to develop talent and we have a proven record.

The Open A Grade competition was won by a truly great side from the Narrabeen Sharks. It was a great exhibition on Grand Final Day, watched by over 4000 people. Well done to the mighty Sharks.

A somewhat surprising, but historic achievement was the success of our District Junior Rugby League U21yrs combined team. This team accepted an invitation to play in the "City of Sydney U21yrs Challenge", an event which was a round robin competition involving teams from other metropolitan Junior Leagues. The team was coached by Chris Reilly, with assistance from Cliff Lyons and Jim Serdaris. The team represented the Manly Warringah Junior League with great distinction, winning the competition as Undefeated Champions, proving once again that our Junior League is bursting with talent.

I would also like to place on record special thanks to our Junior Rugby League Board, Chairman Keith Anderson, Competition Secretaries John Fox and Kim Hunter, Judiciary Chairman Graeme Glover, Senior Registrar Alan Skinner and IT expert, Coralie Newman. Working with them has been a pleasure and the amount of time they give up as volunteers is much appreciated.

As always, I would like to express our sincere gratitude to the Referees, who like so many people involved in the Junior Rugby League, give up so much of their valuable time and without whom the Junior Rugby League could not function.
