Topped up by Four Million Dollars from Warringah Council, it has placed us in a good position at Brookvale. 

COACHING REPORT

Winning an NRL premiership in any season is special but for the Manly Warringah Sea Eagles to achieve the game's holy grail in the Centenary season of Rugby League was monumental for the club, sponsors, players, members and loyal supporters. The 40-nil win over the reigning premiers Melbourne Storm at ANZ Stadium on Sunday, October 5 will go down as one of the most memorable days in the proud history of the Sea Eagles.

It was the result of nothing else but belief and hard work by the players, the loyal and professional coaching, training and medical staff and an understanding Board and two particularly generous and caring owners in the Delmege and Penn families. Without their total support over the past five seasons the return to a premiership for the people of the peninsula wouldn't have been possible.

The grand final win was a salute to years of rebuilding and that includes the professional people in the front office. CEO Grant Mayer and his staff have been outstanding in their work to complement and support what the players were able to achieve on the field. I am grateful for the opportunity to work alongside so many talented people and with an outstanding group of players who took their opportunity with both hands when the time came to produce.

The can be no doubt that the last six weeks of the premiership saw a lift in form at the most appropriate time. During this six week period Manly scored 220 points to 54 for an average 36-9 scoreline in an unbeaten run to a well deserved lap of honour and the club's seventh premiership. The manner in which success was achieved was in the end, not only emphatic, but the result of an attractive and free flowing style which Matt Orford and his side put on show.

Manly scored 140 tries in the season and amassed 755 points - stunning figures. The defence when needed was outstanding and only two tries were scored against the side in three finals appearances. Matt Orford capped a fine season where he was named Dally M winner with some inspirational leadership throughout the final series and in the grand final.

The success of young players who came through Manly's junior representative teams was also a highlight, with Anthony Watmough, Glenn Stewart and Brett Stewart being rewarded with selection in the Australian World Cup squad. So too were players who came to Manly for an opportunity like Josh Perry and David Williams who completed excellent first seasons with us with green and gold selection, joining established Test player, Brent Kite. Three try grand final winger Michael Robertson represented Scotland and centre Steve Matai played for eventual World Cup winner New Zealand. I congratulate all eight players on their selection.

The 2008 season was made all the more special when Steve Menzies completed his magnificent career with a try and a grand final win. It had been a privilege to play alongside Beaver in a premiership but to be part of his fairytale exit was extra special for everyone involved with the club. His record of 349 games for the one club and 180 tries speaks for itself but for such success to come to such a humble and inspirational champion is something that will probably never be equalled in the game. Steve Menzies will always be remembered as an all time great at Manly and many of the 80,000 at ANZ Stadium on grand final day will rightly boast that they were "there" when the Beaver scored his last and most memorable try to put the full stop on an unforgettable journey at the Sea Eagles.

The grand final also farewelled Steve Bell and Mark Bryant who have been key members of the group since they joined the club. So too Luke Williamson who missed the last few games with injury but played such a significant role with the club over the past six seasons.

Over the past couple of seasons Manly have set about reaching goals and exploding myths. We have righted our away from home record and theories that we can't win at places like Toyota Park, Brisbane and Auckland. We have shown that when we need to, we can be as expansive as any side but we can also be as tough as it takes when required. But perhaps our biggest improvement has been off the field where our fans - at home and away- have flocked to our games. The away fans at Brisbane and the Gold Coast have lifted our side in recent years and have become one of the most vocal and supportive in the League. The huge increase in youngsters supporting the club is most gratifying.

On behalf of the players, I would like to thank the supporters for their faith in what we have been trying to achieve in recent years. Our new immediate goals are the upcoming World Club Championship game against the Leeds Rhinos in Leeds on March 1 and then a successful start to our 2009 campaign.

I would like to take this opportunity to wish all members and supporters a safe and happy Xmas and successful and healthy New Year.


