## FOOTBALL CLUB CHAIRMAN’S REPORT

Going back to back in the NRL competition has proven too big a task for the defending Premiers each year since 1992, but I can proudly say that in 2012, Geoff Toovey and the boys gave it a red hot go. Despite a host of difficulties, including pre-season disruptions, travelling to the UK for the World Club Challenge, injuries, suspensions and off field distractions, the team, led by Co-Captains Jamie Lyon and Jason King, rallied together magnificently to finish in the Top 4, falling only one game short of another Grand Final appearance after defeat by eventual 2012 Premiers, the Melbourne Storm. Whilst we may not have achieved our ultimate goal of successfully defending our 2011 title, we should not lose sight of just how difficult it is to remain near the top of the NRL competition each year. Accordingly, we should all be extremely proud of what was still a very successful 2012 season for the Manly-Warringah Sea Eagles.

In his first year as Head Coach, Geoff Toovey did a fantastic job despite a less than ideal preparation and I am sure he is itching to get into 2013, knowing the experience of his first year under his belt will stand him in good stead for the challenges that lie ahead. With the nucleus of the side being retained long term, particularly our young halves, Keiran Foran and Daly Cherry-Evans, we can all be justifiably confident that a 9th premiership is well within our reach in coming seasons.

I would like to congratulate Chief Operating Officer, David Perry and his team for the magnificent job they have done to give Geoff and the entire Football Department the resources they need to be successful, whilst also positioning the Club in a much improved financial position. In a challenging economic climate and ultra competitive Sydney sporting market, this is no easy task and the positive outcomes we have witnessed in 2012 across so many facets of the business are a testament to the commitment, tenacity and talent of the entire administration team.

It is with great pleasure that the Football Club Board recommends the awarding of Life Membership at the 2012 AGM to local juniors, Anthony Watmough and Jason King. Both Choc and Kingy have played over 200 first grade games for the Sea Eagles and were key members of our 2008 and 2011 premiership winning sides. They are both clearly most deserving of this distinguished honour.

During 2012, the Football Club was able to purchase more shares in the Sea Eagles, injecting much needed funds, thanks to the generosity of long time supporter, Anthony Johnston and his company, URM. Our heartfelt thanks go to Anthony for his support. The Football Club is committed to preserving the history and traditions of the Manly-Warringah Sea Eagles and to protecting the rights (control of name, colours, home ground location and right to appoint 2 Directors) given to the Members under the Preference Share issued to the Football Club by the Manly-Warringah Sea Eagles. To that end, your Football Club Board has developed a Position Statement that sets out the principles and goals that guide the actions and decisions of the Football Club in relation to the Preference Share and the Manly-Warringah Sea Eagles generally.

In November, we launched the Football Club's own website, [www.manlyfootballclub.com.au](http://www.manlyfootballclub.com.au), to provide an independent platform for the Football Club to communicate directly with its members. The Football Club's Position Statement described above can be found on the website and we encourage all Members to visit the website and view those goals and guiding principles for yourself so that you might better understand our stance on various issues. Another feature of the new website is that it allows Football Club members to login to the membership section to manage their own membership online, including updating their address and contact details and paying their renewal online. Furthermore, in line with our goal of preserving the history and traditions of our great Club, our aim is to gradually develop the Football Club website into an online “virtual” museum of the Manly-Warringah Sea Eagles. This will be a long term project over many years, but hopefully one that will bring much joy to Sea Eagles fans young and old and ensure that the history and heritage of our great Club lives on forever.

As always, the future of Brookvale Oval remains the key to the long term survival of the Manly-Warringah Sea Eagles Club as we currently know it, and notwithstanding recent State Government announcements about Stadiums in NSW, the Football Club and the Sea Eagles are actively working closely with other stakeholders and continue to lobby all levels of Government for the funding Brookvale Oval deserves. This will continue to be a difficult fight, but one in which ultimately we must prevail and we trust all Members will stand ready to support us as and when required.

Finally, I would like to take this opportunity to wish all Football Club Members and their families a Merry Christmas and safe and happy 2013.

## VALE ROBERT HIGHAM 1919 - 2012

In 1971, Jean Hay, now Manly's Mayor, phoned her brother, then Sea Eagles boss Ken Arthurson, to say she had met a doctor who had an interest in the Sea Eagles. "He's a gynaecologist," she said. "No problems," Arthurson reportedly replied. "He should be right at home - we're playing like a team of sheilas." From that point on, Dr Bob Higham was on the sideline for every game and played an integral role as the Sea Eagles went on to win 4 premierships during the 1970s. Monday mornings in his practice became a curious sight as a mix of wounded footballers and pregnant women lined his waiting room. Bob Higham continued his role as Club Doctor throughout the next decade and in 1983 was given the distinguished honour of being made a Life Member of the Football Club.

When he wasn't patching up footballers, Bob Higham delivered over 10,000 babies at Manly Hospital over 33 years. He was also widely revered for his courage under fire as volunteer medical officer for the Australian military in the Korean conflict in 1953-54. Not surprisingly, many people from all walks of life attended his funeral to say farewell to a northern beaches legend. The Football Club and the Sea Eagles will forever remain indebted to such a wonderful and loyal servant whom shall not be forgotten.



## VALE JASON ANNEAR #543 1991 - 2012



The 2012 season ended on a tragic note for the Manly-Warringah Sea Eagles with the sad passing of promising young player, Jason Annear. Jason had been a part of the Sea Eagles family for the last 6 years having joined the Sea Eagles' Harold Matthews team in 2007 from his junior club, Berkeley Vale Panthers. In 2008, Jason played SG Ball before going on to Captain the 2009 SG Ball team. After two strong seasons in NYC in 2010 and 2011, Jason graduated to the senior ranks in 2012 with the NSW Cup team as a member of the First Grade squad. On several occasions he was on standby as 19th man for First Grade and was unlucky not to make his First Grade debut in 2012.

The smart backrower had just signed a new contract with the Sea Eagles for 2013 and Coach Geoff Toovey had earmarked Jason to make his First Grade debut during the 2013 season. Sadly, Jason has been robbed of the opportunity to fulfill his dream of playing in the NRL.

The Football Club is proud to award Jason the First Grade Player #543 in recognition of a promising young career cruelly cut short and as a lasting tribute to a fine young man and great clubman whom shall not be forgotten by his Sea Eagles family.

## CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER'S REPORT

My first full year leading this great club has proven to be a challenging one, but I am happy to report that, despite the many challenges both on and off the field, we have ended 2012 with another successful football result for the team and an improved financial position for the Club off the field.

Whilst we were all disappointed with our final game of the 2012 season, Geoff Toovey, his coaching staff and all the players deserve enormous credit for the way in which they handled the difficulties associated with the disruptive impact of suspensions and an unusually high level of injuries. It is testament to their collective skill, dedication and closeness that the team was able to perform so well throughout what was a very tough season. Backing up as defending Premiers is never an easy task. The 2013 playing roster is not yet completely finalised as we continue to manage salary cap challenges, but it is already clear that the recruiting of 13 new faces into our overall squad has created an exciting vibe within the group and there is a great feeling of optimism and excitement for the coming season.

Off the field our staff worked tirelessly throughout the year to engage more effectively than ever before with our business partners, community partners, members and operational stakeholders. Our membership growth (comparing like for like) grew 21% over the previous year which compares very favourably against the average of all Clubs across the Competition of 1.55%.

We introduced a more disciplined and systematic approach to engaging with our business partners - regular networking events, consistent email communications, customised sponsorship packages - and the benefits of this can already be seen with a record number of 2012 partners having already renewed for the 2013 season. Of course, the re-signing of our Naming Partner Kaspersky Lab for a further 3 years was a huge positive for the Club and also a gratifying compliment to some of the changes we have made that aim to provide value for sponsors. I thank Kaspersky Lab for their loyalty and support and urge all Sea Eagles members and fans to support their products at every opportunity.

Our involvement in the community has again been a highlight in 2012 with our work in supporting improved literacy outcomes being widely recognised and praised. This year, in addition to supporting local charity organisations (Royal Far West, Stewart House, Cerebral Palsy Alliance, Aim for the Stars, Lifeline) we introduced a strong focus on diabetes awareness in children with excellent results and we will continue to expand our support of this cause in 2013. Also in 2013 we will embark on a deliberate and committed strategy to re-engage with the Junior League clubs across the district as this is an area that needs much more focus and support than we have given in recent years.

We are also very pleased with the improvements that have been made over the past 12 months in the digital space. All areas of our digital operation - mobile app, Facebook, Twitter, website (including Sea Eagles TV) - are showing growth and improved branding and increased levels of interaction with our members, fans and stakeholders. This growth is planned to continue as we combine with NRL related digital strategies and continue to grow our internal capabilities through investment in training, equipment and appropriately skilled staff.

Brookvale Oval remains a concern for us and I must report that progress on planned upgrades was frustratingly slow in 2012. Council had planned to have the Jane Try extension, including the new Corporate Lounge, public food and beverage outlets and new toilets, fully finished by April 2012 but, at time of writing, this work is still not completed. Whilst this project is not directly under our control, we continue to work with Council and we are certainly looking forward to all of these facilities being available in 2013. Whilst the additional 300 undercover reserved seats and the new Corporate Lounge from the extension are appreciated and valuable, those upgrades alone remain insufficient for our long term needs and so we continue to lobby Government at all levels to try to get the financial backing to allow Brookvale Oval to be further upgraded to meet acceptable modern day stadium requirements.

Finally, I want to thank everyone associated with the Club for their loyalty and commitment to supporting us in 2012. My job is firstly, to support Geoff Toovey and the Football Department in any way I can and secondly, to continue to manage the transition from football "club" to football "business" in order to ensure our great Club's long term survival. I feel that we made valuable progress in 2012 by putting in place a range of business procedures that will help sustain us into the future but the task is ongoing and the current business environment is unforgiving. We will continue in 2013 to fight for financial stability whilst doing everything we can to support Geoff, all of our staff, our players, our members, Business Partners and our owners, the Football Club, Penn Sport and Quantum.

To all Football Club members, I wish you a safe and Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year. I look forward to seeing you get behind Geoff and the boys in 2013.
